# CT 25 SAC CRITERIA FOR CERTIFICATION BODIES (COLD CHAIN MANAGEMENT SYSTEM)

### 1 Introduction

- 1.1 This document specifies the supplementary SAC criteria for Certification Bodies (CBs) certifying Cold Chain Management System (CCMS).
- 1.2 This document is to be used with:
  - a. ISO/IEC 17021-1 Conformity Assessment Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems
  - b. Applicable IAF Mandatory Documents

### 2 Certification Criteria

- 2.1 CBs shall audit and certify organisations to SS 668: Part 1: 2020 Cold chain management of chilled and frozen foods Part 1: General requirements.
- 2.2 The following standards shall be used as references, where applicable.
  - a. SS 668: Part 2: 2020Cold chain management of chilled and frozen foods Part 2: Code of practice for meat
  - SS 668 Part 3: 2020 Cold chain management of chilled and frozen foods –
     Part 3: Code of practice for vegetables and fruits
  - c. SS 668: Part 4: 2020 Cold chain management of chilled and frozen foods –
     Part 4: Code of practice for fish
  - d. SS 668: Part 5: 2020Cold chain management of chilled and frozen foods –
     Part 5: Code of practice for chilled table eggs

### 3 Criteria for CCMS Auditors

- 3.1 CBs shall appoint qualified auditors to conduct CCMS audits.
- 3.2 Auditors shall meet the criteria as defined in **Annex A (Normative)** of this document.
- 3.3 If there is only one person conducting the audit, this person shall fulfil the requirements for lead auditor defined in **Annex A (Normative)** of this document.

### 4 Duration of CCMS Audits

- 4.1 Determination of audit time for CCMS audits shall be based on Annex A of IAF Mandatory Document 5 (IAF MD 5) Determination of audit time of quality, environmental, and occupational health & safety management systems.
- 4.2 In determining the audit duration, a CB shall determine the effective number of personnel in an organisation. This includes full time staff and associates. Where applicable, references shall be made to IAF MD 5.
- 4.3 For requirements for stage 1 and stage 2 audits, CBs shall refer to clause 9.3 of ISO/IEC 17021-1.
- 4.4 For multi-sites audit, the size of the sample shall follow IAF Mandatory Document 1 (IAF MD 1) – Audit and certification of a management system operated by a multi-site organisation.

- 4.5 CB shall calculate the audit time. In all cases where adjustments are made to the audit duration provided in Annex A of IAF MD 5, sufficient evidence and records shall be maintained to justify the variation. Where applicable, references shall be made to IAF MD 5.
- 4.6 In order to ensure effective audits being performed and to ensure reliable and comparable results, the audit time shall not be reduced by more than 30% based on the audit time provided in Annex A of IAF MD 5.
- 4.7 Surveillance audit duration shall be 1/3 of initial audit duration.
- 4.8 Recertification audit duration shall be 2/3 of initial audit duration.
- 4.9 If after the calculation the result is a decimal number, the number of auditor days should be adjusted to the nearest half day (e.g. 1.3 auditor days becomes 1.5 auditor days, 1.2 auditor days becomes 1 auditor day).

## 5 Cold Chain Boundary

5.1 CB shall ensure that the certification scope as reflected in the certification certificate is appropriate to the types of products and services covered.
